Grüner Grashalm e.V is launching a new call for participants! This time we are going to Balkan Exploration from 9 to 23 of July! We will travel to **Bosnia**, **Croatia**, **Slovenia**, **and Kosovo** by **hitchhiking** to find answers to questions about the First World War.

The project is a continuation of a multipart international youth and film project, which takes place on the original venues of the First World War. In small groups participants will go back in time from country to country visiting places of war memorials and learning from the past. Participants will meet local people and speak to them, visit youth organizations on the way, museums and memorials. The intense contact with local environment gives the possibility to meet refugees, border guard of the newly constructed walls (Hungary), and people who actively participate in the local initiatives working on the peaceful solutions to the migration problem.

Together we will answer for example the following questions:

- To what extent is there a connection between the events which happened 100 years ago and now?
- How important is the civil engagement?
- How do people now handle the heritage of the past?



Adventures

We will get to know you each other with hiking excursions in the foothills of Bavarian Alps, then hitchhike in groups of 2-3 people to each of the projects that work towards peace in the Balkans.

We pay

We reimburse 100 euros for transportation to Siegsdorf, Germany and from Gračenica, Kosovo. For Russian participants this summ is 150 euros. Food and logging will be fully covered during the 14-day project. Participation fee - 25€






Siegsdorf, Germany




Ljubljana, Slovenia


